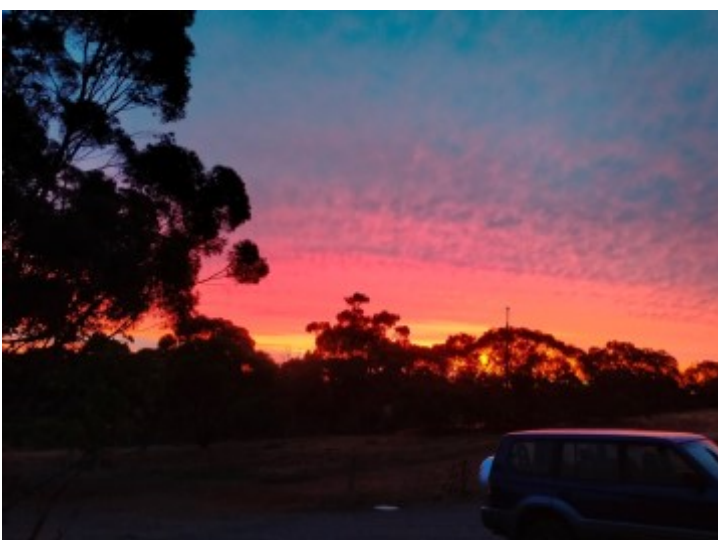

With the watchful eye of a guardian, we can find balance to keep our waters calm.”



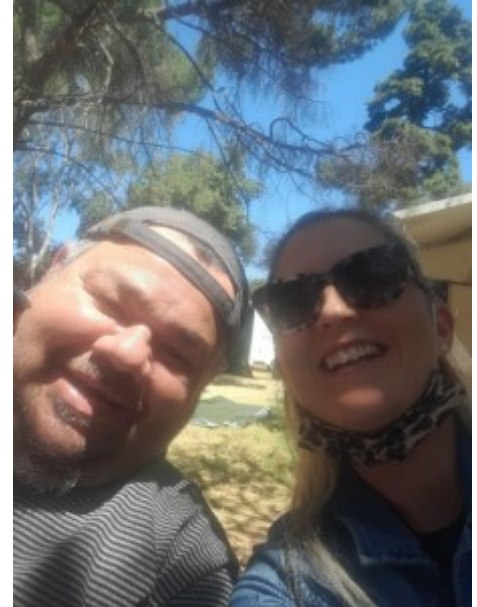
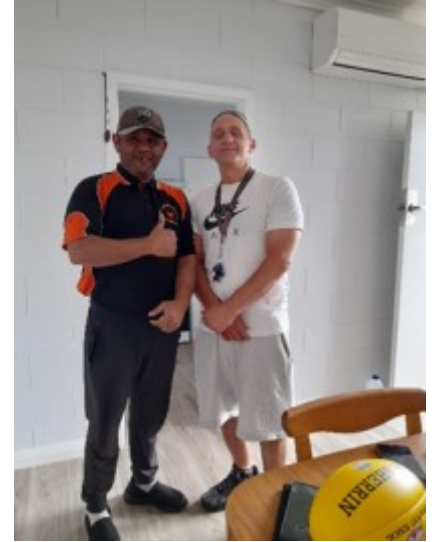
New Youth Group
